The Emerging Leader Award is given to a nonprofit professional who has made a significant impact in strengthening the North Dakota nonprofit sector in a short amount of time within the field through his/her commitment to leadership, volunteerism, and/or philanthropy. This award is presented too early to mid-career leaders, those with less than 10 years of experience in the nonprofit sector.

Matthew Ternus, in the seven years he has been in the Greater Grand Forks area, has embodied what it means to be a servant leader. Ternus seeks collaborative approaches to problem solving that engages all corners of a community and seeks to create a table where everyone is invited to partake in conversations. He often aims to take in as much information and analyze, allowing himself to provide thoughtful and creative ideas in any group setting. Ternus consistently shows up, volunteers to assist when needed, and works to create a positive and enthusiastic environment with all he works with.
