- ✓ Include nonprofits in shaping and advancing North Dakota's economic and workforce development strategies.
- ✓ Insist that grants and contracts with nonprofits reflect the true costs of sustaining a mission-driven business.

Nonprofit entities provide countless services to the community in health care, human services, education, arts and culture, and more.
