

Support people and organizations working on any issue that is most important to their communities.






# Community Innovation Programs

The Bush Foundation provides Community Innovation grants of \$10,000 to \$200,000. Grants under \$20,000 are available from our intermediary partner



The Bush Prize for Community Innovation celebrates organizations with a track record of successful community problem solving. Bush Prize winners are extraordinary not only in what they do, but in how they do it. They work inclusively, in partnership with others, to make our region better for everyone.

Winners receive a package of recognition, including a flexible grant of 25% of the organization's last fiscal year expenses, up to \$500,000.

### **About Event Sponsorship Grants**

The Bush Foundation believes in developing and supporting leaders who can create positive change in our region.

To that end, we dedicate a limited amount of funds every year to sponsor events that inspire, equip and connect people to think bigger and think differently about what's possible in their communities and to lead more effectively.

In this time of pandemic, events are particularly affected as in-person gatherings pose a real public safety risk. At this point, we anticipate that we will only fund virtual events for the remainder of 2020. Given this assumption, plus the number of event cancellations, the typically lower cost of virtual events, and the urgent basic needs in our region, we are reducing the funding for additional 2020 event sponsorships by 50%. We will repurpose that funding toward COVID-19 response. In this very unusual and uncertain time, it is as important as ever that we find ways to connect and support each other. And to be creative and resourceful in new ways, including how we gather.

We encourage all event organizers to follow the latest guidelines from the CDC and your state or tribal government's health officials. We will stay in touch to be supportive of our existing grantees, and will be flexible in adjusting timelines as needed to postpone or change an event.

### 2020 COVID-19 response so far

With the money repurposed from the Bush Prize, we made several grants to response efforts assisting communities across our region:

- •\$1 million to the Minnesota Disaster Recovery Fund.
- •\$500,000 to the Dakota Medical Foundation's Critical Safety Net Fund serving North Dakota and northwest Minnesota.
- •\$500,000 to the South Dakota Community Foundation's Coronavirus Response Fund.
- •\$500,000 to the NDN Collective Covid-19 Project to provide immediate relief to Indigenous communities in our region.
